Correction and Rehabilitation of Penitent Offenders

Objective:

To effect the rehabilitation and reintegration of probationers, parolees, pardonees, and first-time minor drug offenders as productive, law-abiding and socially responsible members of the community through

1. well-planned supervision programs for probationers, parolees, pardonees, and first-time minor drug offenders which are aligned to national program thrusts of the government, and
2. establishment of innovative, and financially and technically feasible projects for the moral, spiritual and economic upliftment of probationers, parolees, pardonees, and first-time minor drug offenders utilizing available community resources.

Scope and Beneficiaries:

All offenders granted probation, parole, pardon and suspended sentence.

The Administration has adopted a harmonized and integrated treatment program for these clients to effect their rehabilitation. This harmonized and integrated program involves (1) Therapeutic Community Modality, (2) Restorative Justice Principles and Concepts, and (3) Use of Volunteer Probation Aides (VPAs).
